Intern will learn to use the NIFA Leadership Management Dashboard and create standard grant award data tables for each state and major grantee institutions. These will be used by the Communications Staff for briefings and travel packages and others as needed for assessments and general information. Web creation tools will be used to complete many of the assignments. Intern will learn to use the REEIS search tool, the Leadership Management Dashboard and other outcome gathering techniques to help write brief outcome stories for use in agency documents.

Skills in effective written communication especially as it pertains to the web writing and using plain language.

Skills in analytical and critical thinking.

Knowledge and skills in the use of computer software and technology.
